Sparking The Flames Of Revival: Ep. 4 When You Fast Matthew 6:16-18

"When you fast, do not look somber as the hypocrites do, for they disfigure their faces to show others they are fasting. Truly I tell you, they have received their reward in full. ¹⁷ **But when you fast,** put oil on your head and wash your face, ¹⁸ so that it will not be obvious to others that you are fasting, but only to your Father, who is unseen; and your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you.

Fasting is a component of the <u>inward</u>, <u>secret and invisible spiritual life</u>. *OPEN SPACES

Fasting is the willful refraining from eating for a period of time.

*Religious— Brings into alignment Spirit, Mind and Body

Invisible Essentials

Vs. 17 But when you fast, put oil on your head and wash your face, ¹⁸ so that it will not be obvious to others that you are fasting, but only to your Father, who is unseen; and your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you.

- **ESSENTIALS:** "But when you" Jesus is more speaking of <u>essentials of the faith here rather than a smorgasbord.</u>
- INVISIBLE: "your Father, who is unseen"— Jesus here is speaking of being Spirits in a material world. *The Ghost In The Machine!

Hypocrites and Oil

Vs. 17 "do not look somber as the **hypocrites** do

- "As the hypocrites do"—"The word hypocrite is rooted in the Greek word hypokrites, which means "stage actor, pretender, dissembler."
- "put oil on your head and wash your face" This counter-intuitive command is based on *Jesus' Revolutionary Upside Down Kingdom*.
 - The Bible, A Good ATTITUDE and a Smile

¹ The "*ghost in the machine*" is British philosopher Gilbert Ryle's description of René Descartes' mind-body dualism

Rewards from a Father

Vs. 18 and your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you.

- "And your Father who sees"
 - We do not serve an absentee Father.
 - American studies into the seemingly <u>incontestable link</u>² between fatherlessness³ and delinquency date back to the mid-1800s.
 - The Father identity is inseparable from the Christian worldview and its understanding of the nuclear family.
- "Will reward you"— We serve a generous God of extravagance.

Gift, Prize and Reward

Food for the Journey: Questions and challenges to go deeper in individual reflection or in one of our community groups.

- 1. If the inward life is a generator for the outward existence, what are some ways to make sure that our life is being empowered from within?
- 2. How much consideration do you give to the invisible life?
- 3. Hypocrisy turns you into an external actor whose incongruence of inward ideals and outward expressions become a mockery to God. Why would God hate hypocrisy?
- 4. Why would God choose to make his role as a loving Father so prevalent in the bible?
- 5. What would a reward from God look like and why would God reward us when he has already given us salvation in Jesus. Is that not enough?
