### **UNCHARTED // Episode 3 : StreetWise**

#### **Proverbs 1:20-23 (HCSB)**

<sup>20</sup> Wisdom calls out in the street; **she** raises her voice in the public squares. <sup>21</sup> She cries out above the commotion; she speaks at the entrance of the city gates: <sup>22</sup> "How long, foolish ones, will you love ignorance? How long will you mockers enjoy mocking and you fools hate knowledge? <sup>23</sup> If you respond to my warning, then I will pour out my spirit on you and teach you my words.

**Streetwise -** Possessing the skills and attitudes necessary to survive in a difficult or dangerous situation or environment.

### 3 Keys to the message:

- 1. Understanding wisdom as a personification of the attributes of God.
- 2. Wisdom will be poured out upon God's people.
- 3. Creating a plan for attaining uncharted wisdom.

# Wisdom is the shepherd of our emotions and actions.

### The Bible personifies Wisdom -

- Wisdom is a personified attribute of God.
- Wisdom is seen as a feminine voice in the scripture (Job 38-41, Proverbs 8)
  - Is Solomon putting forth a claim that women are wiser than men?
  - Is Solomon establishing a god-like cult of female wisdom worship?

**Vs. 20** Wisdom calls out in the street; **she** raises her voice in the public squares.

- Was it due to a cultural rise in the authority of women during periods of antiquity?
- Was it God's way of expressing a unique quality of his nature he imbued to women?

**Vs. 21** She cries out above the **commotion**; she speaks at the entrance of the city gates.

- Wisdom cries and speaks in two places, the town squares and at the city gates.
- A partnership of wisdom between man and wife is found in Proverbs 3:23 and Proverbs 8:1.
- Leaning on the counsel of the wise woman- Proverbs 31:11 Her husband has full confidence in her and lacks nothing of value.

### 2. Wisdom will be poured out upon God's People -

**Vs. 23** If you respond to my warning, then I will pour out my spirit on you and teach you my words.

- In the Old Testament, the Holy Spirit is often seen as a spirit of Wisdom.
- In the Old Testament the Spirit is often poured out upon, whereas in the New Testament, we experience the indwelling of the Holy Spirit.
  - Galatians 4:6 Because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into our hearts, crying, "Abba! Father!"

## 3. Creating a plan for attaining uncharted wisdom.

- Be hungry for wisdom- James 1:6 If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you. NIV
- Be rooted Psalm 1 Blessed is the one who does not walk in step with the wicked or stand in the way that sinners take or sit in the company of mockers, ¿but whose delight is in the law of the LORD, and who meditates on his law day and night. That person is like a tree planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in season and whose leaf does not wither—whatever they do prospers.
- Be Humble Proverbs 11:2 When pride comes, then comes disgrace, but with humility comes wisdom.
- Get Counsel Proverbs 15:22 Without counsel plans fail, but with many advisers they succeed.
- **Don't be double minded James 1:7-8** That man should not expect to receive anything from the Lord. <sup>8</sup> He is a double-minded man, unstable in all his ways.
